Pharmacological Management Acute drug therapy refers to the treatment of individual attacks of headache in patients with episodic and chronic TTH. Most headaches in patients with episodic TTH are mild to moderate and the patients can often self-manage by using simple analgesics.

Guideline for primary care management of headache in adults

The Alberta guideline is intended to assist any primary care practitioner responsible for the assessment and management of headaches in adults. The guideline's main focus is primary headache disorders (eg, migraine, tension-type, and cluster headache) and medication-overuse headache.

Headache management: pharmacological approaches ...

Migraine is a common and disabling primary headache disorder and is the focus of this article. We also briefly consider the other common primary headache disorders, tension-type headache, cluster headache and also the management of medication-overuse headache.

Management often requires the simultaneous use of these different treatments. (See "Chronic migraine", section on 'Management'.) For chronic tension-type headache, effective treatment involves the use of daily preventive medications (eg, tricyclic antidepressants), behavioral therapies and physical therapy. Like chronic migraine, the combined use of these interventions is often best.
