Rental Equipment Rates

Rental rates are based on an 8-HOUR DAY, 40-HOUR WEEK, 160-HOUR (4-WEEK) MONTH. Overtime charges will be prorated at 1/8 of the Daily Rate for each hour over eight hours in a day. Rental charges will continue until the unit has been returned and checked in at BURRIS EQUIPMENT or notice has been given that the equipment is ready to be picked up.

This section contains the Equipment Rental Costs

Monthly rental rates vary from 2% to 5% of the purchase price of the equipment depending on the anticipated life of the equipment and its wearing parts. Weekly rental rates are about 1/3 the monthly rates, and daily rental rates are about 1/3 the weekly rate. Rental rates can also be treated as reimbursement costs for contractor-owned equipment.

Construction. Therefore, the FHWA will accept use of 50 percent of the ownership rental rates of an approved guide as the standby rate in lieu of a contractor's actual standby costs. Standby time should not exceed 8 hours per day, 40 hours per week, or the annual usage hours as established by the rate guide.
